News came to one our homes early this morning that a little boy (unknown to any of us) was in hospital having an urgent heart operation.

Two of our older boys volunteered to give blood so this little boy could get through the operation.

Those of you that have never been to a third world nation may not understand the blessing and the importance of the giving of blood.

Firstly the risk of HIV/Aids in this nation is so great that not anybodies blood can be used.

Secondly those that do give blood always expect some form of payment.

There are also other things considered.

But the **key** blessing I am expressing is that our LIA young men who were suitable blood donors did so out of a pure motivation of love for their own people. They put their hand up in helping to save of this precious little boy's life and did so for no other reason,

"Mama we just wanted him to live".
