## Team Information

### Costings Per Stay

#### Per team:

- \* \$30 US dollars per team for pick up and set down for travel to and from the airport In our van ( \$15per way)
- \* \$80 US for medicines for Svay Reing clinics.
- \*\$150 Petrol & Van cost for travel to the medical clinics
- \* \$20 US Visa per person upon entry
- \*\$30 US donation to the lady in the village, whose home you camp under and we run the clinic base.( It's polite to give a donation)
- \* 25 US departure tax per person

**Total In US : \$ 335.00**

**Please Note: A deposit of \$150 per team is required to cover any damages or undue cost that may occur during the teams stay this will be refunded upon departure.**

**Visa:** You can purchase your visa before you leave your country or once you arrive in Cambodia coming through the airport. (The later is easiest & best)

To get a visa in Cambodia you will need; \* a spare passport photo

\* \$20 US dollars (tourist visa)

\* \$25 US dollars (business visa)

If you are staying longer than one month you need to purchase a business visa as this lasts three months and it saves having to depart the country after one month. A business visa is renewed while being allowed to continue in the country.

When filling in the reason for your visit do not put Christian ministry or work as they then become very suspicious of what you are doing in the country and it can make it difficult for the christian works you are volunteering for.

Put tourist or aid worker that will be sufficient.

## **Per Person**

\* \$15 US Dollars per person per day (\$105 per week ) accommodation at LIA this covers tea and coffee at all times and the cost of using our facilities.

\* \$10 US Individual Travel by Tuk Tuk's or moto's per person. Depends on how much they travel around.

\* \$2 - \$5 US per day. Lunch money per day as LIA does not provide lunch. You can go to local supermarkets in Phnom Pehn and purchase things for lunches. Cold meats, Hot chickens, salads. You can eat out at nice cafe's in Phnom Pehn for \$2-\$5 US dollars. Purchase fruit in the local markets etc.

\* Toul Sleng Museum, very educational for all teams, was once the jail that Pol Pot tortured, jailed & killed the people in the Khmer Rouge Genocide. It has graphic pictures etc so it is up to the parents whether they chose to let their kids go.

It includes a photographs and examples of torture etc .

You can have lunch at a nice cafe outside this museum. It takes about half a day to do this full round tour.

Cost: US \$2 entry to museum

Tuk Tuk Travel Return Cost: US \$1-50 (5-6 people).

\* Spending money depends on the individual \$100 can buy a good amount depends on your bartering skills or what you buy .

Any other costs that are incurred are covered by the individual person. If they decide to do any extra activities.
